



The Ingelhart Award for Freedom of Expression

The Ingelhart Award recognizes the student, media organization, media adviser, journalism educator or working journalist who contributes to freedom of expression at the risk or personal or professional cost. It is named for the "great one" of collegiate journalism, Louis Ingelhart. It is awarded on occasion, not yearly. The recipient of this award must be affiliated with an SCJ member campus or nominated by an SCJ member. It is the only SCJ Award that may be awarded to non-members.
